REGISTRATION OPENS: Thursday at 10:00 a.m.
REGISTRATION CLOSURES: Friday at 12:00 MIDNIGHT
PARADE STAGING: Saturday: From 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.
PARADE START: 9:30 a.m. SHARP
AT COMPLETION OF PARADE
RETURN TO POWWOW GRAND ENTRY BY 1:30 p.m.

PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED FOR DANCERS AND SINGERS:

All dancers/singers **MUST PRE-REGISTER** if participating in the Parade. Participants must sign up for the Parade at the same time as competition registration. A "YELLOW" Parade Number Card will be assigned.

Yellow Parade cards will be distributed at the Department of Transportation Parking Lot on Saturday and **MAY ONLY BE PICKED UP BY THE PARTICIPATING INDIVIDUAL** before 9:00 a.m. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

REGISTRATION FOR FLOATS:

If not pre-registered, all float participants must register Saturday with the Parade Volunteer at United Tribes Technical College's registration table located at the Department of Transportation Parking Lot between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. (All numbers will be distributed at this time.) **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS:

Please be in your assigned positions by 9:00 a.m.
If not, the parade will proceed without you.
PARADE starts promptly at 9:30 a.m.
It will begin at the State Capital Grounds
and end at the Kirkwood Mall.

PLEASE BE PROMPT AND ON TIME!

RULES FOR ALL PARADE PARTICIPANTS:

1. All Parade entrants **MUST PARTICIPATE** in the **ENTIRE Parade**. Fifty (50) points will be given to dancers and singers for participation. Any dancers/singers dropping out early or arriving late will forfeit their points.

2. Parade Number Cards and Dancer Number Cards must be identical numbers and must be worn on the **LEFT SIDE** where visible to judges.
3. All dancers must be in full regalia at the start of the Parade. **NO CAPS OR HATS** are allowed.
4. **ALL POWWOW DANCERS and SINGERS MUST TURN IN THEIR PARADE NUMBER IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE PARADE. Do not destroy or mutilate cards - make sure numbers remain readable. Cards deemed unreadable will become VOID and thus points forfeited.**

A table will be available for drop-off at the Staging Area at the Kirkwood Mall Parking Lot. **CARDS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AT ANY OTHER GIVEN TIME OR PLACE. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Number cards will then be turned in by Parade Registration Personnel to the Powwow Scorekeepers for tabulation of points received.

5. Floats will be judged during the Parade by a panel of judges. Winning floats will be announced and awards given at the Lone Star Arena before the 1:30 p.m. Grand Entry.
6. The Parade Committee reserves the right to refuse entrance to any individual(s) who is (are) intoxicated, disruptive or deemed improper.
